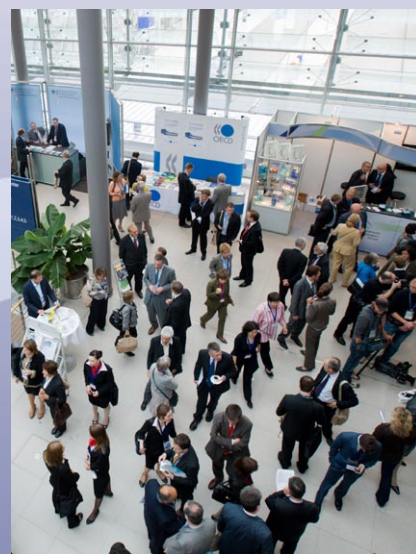
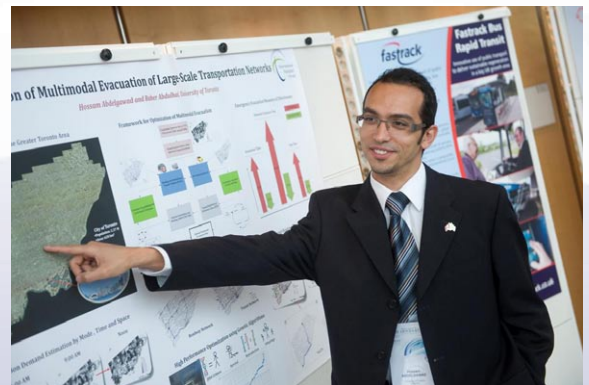

# POSTER EXHIBIT

The 2011 International Transport Forum will be held in Leipzig, Germany on 25-27 May 2011 on the topic **TRANSPORT *for* SOCIETY**. Transport Ministers and other leading figures from industry, civil society and research, as well as the media, are among the more than 800 people who will attend the Forum. This annual event offers unique dissemination and networking opportunities for transport professionals and researchers from around the world.





## POSTER EXHIBIT

The 2011 International Transport Forum will feature an exhibition of posters displaying recent and interesting research in an area of high-visibility to Forum participants. The poster exhibit will be announced in the Forum programme and on the web site, as well as through information displayed on site. A specific dedicated poster session will be organised during the event. Each contributor will have an opportunity in advance of the poster session to focus attention on the key project idea highlighted in their poster during a one-minute presentation to conference participants.

## The International Transport Forum

*The International Transport Forum is a strategic think tank for the transport sector. Each year, it brings together Ministers from over 50 countries, along with leading decision-makers and actors from the private sector, civil society and research, to address transport issues of strategic importance. An intergovernmental organisation linked to the OECD, the Forum's goal is to help shape the transport policy agenda, and ensure that it contributes to economic growth, environmental protection, social inclusion and the preservation of human life and wellbeing.*

## CANDIDATES

Universities, research laboratories, consultancy firms, research consortiums, foundations and international organisations located in a Forum member country\* are invited to apply to participate in this poster exhibit. Interested parties should complete a **registration form** describing the key aspects of the research they wish to exhibit (deadline **11 March 2011**), and highlighting the relevance to the Forum 2011 theme **TRANSPORT for SOCIETY**. A selection Committee will choose those posters that best highlight innovative research linked to the 2011 theme.
