

INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON MEASURING INVESTMENT IN TRANSPORT INFRASTRUCTURE

Why?

Infrastructure investments are a key determinant of performance in the transport sector.

However, the sector lacks standardised definitions and methods for measuring investment.

The lack of clear definitions and common practices hinders meaningful analysis and comparison, leading to inaccuracy in decision making.

Objectives and Outcomes

The goal is for the stakeholders to develop a more consistent international framework for transport investment statistics so that the impact of transport investment on the economy can be better understood/quantified.

Findings from the workshop will serve as inputs to the International Transport Forum's Summit on "Funding Transport" to be held in May 2013.
